

Announcement from the Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, on Business Information Technology Undergraduate Scholarship for Overseas Students In Academic Year 2020

Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang is calling for applications for Business Information Technology Undergraduate Scholarship (2020). Overseas students must satisfy the requirements below. Candidate selection is based on academic excellence as determined from academic records, standardized test scores, academic portfolios, and an interview.

1. Business Information Technology Undergraduate Scholarship

- 1.1 Fully-funded Scholarships for International Students living outside of Thailand.
 - 1.1.1 Up to 2 awards per year
 - 1.1.2 Full tuition fee exemption during the normal 4-year study period (excluding any fee payable to other academic institutions).
 - 1.1.3 Monthly allowance of 9,000 Thai Baht.

2. Requirements

The applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- 2.1 The applicants must have a current residential address in a country other than Thailand.
- 2.2 The applicants must meet the minimum requirement of one of the following mathematical proficiency criteria:

| Gaokao score of Mathematics | 90 (out of 150) |

- 2.3 The applicants must meet one of the following English proficiency criteria:
 - 2.3.1 The applicants have studied abroad in a school that teaches in English at the high school level or an equivalent level for more than 2 consecutive years <u>or</u>
 - 2.3.2 The applicants have obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> and meet the minimum requirements specified:

| English Test | Required Score |

| TOEFL (ITP or paper-based test) | 500 |
| IELTS | 5 |
| Cambridge English Exams – FCE or CAE or CPE | 160 |

4. Supporting documents

Scholarship candidates must provide the following documents:

- 4.1 Complete the application form on https://www.it.kmitl.ac.th/en/admission-en/bach-scholarship/
 - 4.2 A photocopy of his or her Official Academic Transcript
 - 4.3 A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
 - 4.4 A color photo (25 mm x 30 mm) of himself or herself
 - 4.5 Recommendation letters from teachers or supervisors
 - 4.6 Official score reports satisfying the requirements in section 2.2 and 2.3 above
 - 4.7 A curriculum vitae or portfolio

5. Selection

Selection of a candidate is based on the applicant's academic records, Mathematical and English proficiency scores, extra-curricular activities, and an interview.

6. Conditions

The awardee must comply with these conditions:

- 6.1 The awardee's first-semester grade point score (GPS) must be at least 3.25 and the awardee must also have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.25. In addition, the awardee must not receive a GPS of less than 3.00 in any given semester.
- 6.2 The awardee must not fail (F) any subject.
- 6.3 The awardee has good behaviors and never breaks the student discipline code.
- 6.4 The awardee is required to work as a teaching assistant or a research assistant at the information Technology faculty.

Note: If the awardee does not comply with the above conditions, the faculty may suspend the fund for the next semester or the rest of the course.
