4. Qualifications of applicants

Qualifications of applicants are as defined in the curriculum and stated in the attached document entitled "**applicant qualifications and admission exam format**". Applicants must thoroughly check whether their qualifications meet the requirements of the specific program they are applying for. At any stage in the admission process, if it is found that the applicant's qualifications do not match the requirements of the program, the faculty has the right to revoke his or her admission right without refunding the fee that he or she has paid for taking the admission exam, with no exception whatsoever.

Applicants for a doctoral degree program must provide their English test results, meeting the criteria outlined in the table below. The submitted result should be from an English test taken within the last 2 years. If the applicant has graduated from an institute in an English-speaking country or completed a curriculum taught in English, they are exempt from submitting an English test score.

Passing English test score threshold (for each test)

**** If your English test score falls below the threshold specified in the table, you may address this deficiency by registering for and completing the examination of specialized English courses outlined in the School of Liberal Arts, KMITL announcement within one year. Failure to fulfill this requirement will lead to the termination of your student status.**

5. Application method

- Online application is via <https://new.reg.kmitl.ac.th/>
- The application fee is 500 Baht and can be paid to a KMITL account at Kasikorn Bank.

The invoice for this fee can be printed from the application process system, and the fee can be paid via two channels below:

1. Via mobile Banking app by scanning the barcode (no fee for making the payment);

Or

2. Paying at a bank teller counter of any Kasikorn Bank in Thailand with a 10 Baht fee for making the payment. Paying at a counter of any other bank may incur an additional payment fee.

(Application fees are not refundable and KMITL will not be responsible for any loss from making payment by methods other than those stated above)

6. Admission test

Details of the admission test method can be seen in the attached document on "**applicant qualifications and admission test method**" for each curriculum.

7. Required pieces of evidence for an interview:

- 7.1 A copy of his or her citizen ID card, correctly certified,
- 7.2 Proof of payment from the bank,
- 7.3 A copy of his or her transcript, showing all records of completed courses up until graduation or the time of application (in the case that the applicant is still in the final semester of the program he or she is attending),
- 7.4 Additional Documents as required by each program. See the details of each program in "Applicant Qualifications and Application Method".

8. Confirmation of admission right and payment of tuition fees

Applicants who have passed the admission test must confirm his or her admission right via www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and pay the admission confirmation fee (which is the same amount as the tuition fee for the admitted semester, stated in clause 2), via a bank counter. If an applicant does not confirm his or her admission right within the specified date and time, it will be taken that the applicant has canceled his or her admission right. For an applicant who has already confirmed his or her admission right and paid the tuition fee, in no case will his or her payment be refunded. Details of the confirmation process and payment of tuition fees can be seen in the announced list of applicants with an admission right.

9. New students reporting to the institute

Applicants who have confirmed their admission right and paid the tuition fees must report themselves to the institute at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th/matriculation (to understand the required documents and reporting process for matriculation, please refer to the announced list of applicants granted admission).
